May 27th, 2020 - the growing anti war movement alarmed many in the u s government on august 16 1966 the house un american activities mittee huac began investigations of americans who were suspected of aiding the nlf with the intent to introduce legislation making these activities illegal anti war demonstrators disrupted the meeting and 50 were arrested' 'world war ii and peace movements 1939 1945
